The Energy Facilities Siting Board ("Siting Board") will conduct a hybrid Siting Board Meeting on **Wednesday, September 30, 2026, beginning at 9:30 AM.**

The Siting Board will consider the following business at the Siting Board Meeting:

I. Consideration of a Tentative Decision in the matter of Hingham Municipal Lighting Plant ("HMLP") and NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a Eversource Energy ("Eversource") for approval to construct three project components (collectively, the "Project"): (1) an open-air tap station ("New Tap Station") in the Town of Weymouth, to tap into an existing Eversource transmission line; (2) an approximately 3.2-mile, 115 kilovolt ("kV") underground transmission line ("New Transmission Line") to run from the New Tap Station to the transfer station site off Hobart Street in the Town of Hingham; and (3) an enclosed substation at the Hobart Street transfer station site ("New Substation") to receive electricity from the New Transmission Line and distribute it to HMLP's customers. The Siting Board will conduct a public meeting regarding the Project, to listen to comments, deliberate, and vote on whether to approve, approve with conditions or amendments, or reject the Tentative Decision.
