The Siting Board will consider the following business at the Siting Board Meeting:

I. Consideration of a Tentative Decision in the matter of NSTAR Electric Company d/b/a Eversource Energy (the “Company”) to expand its existing Crystal Spring Substation in Mattapoisett, to install a three-mile extension of an existing transmission line in Acushnet and Mattapoisett to connect to that substation, and to make related improvements. The purpose of the meeting is for the Siting Board to listen to comments, deliberate, and vote on whether to grant the Company individual zoning exemptions and a comprehensive exemption from provisions of the Town of Mattapoisett’s Zoning Bylaws to enable the Project to proceed.
